



## Hunting Checklist

### You should bring:

- Vehicle capable of traversing rocky roads - 4x4 recommended
- Valid Texas hunting license and Hunter's Ed Cert if applicable
- Gun(s) and ammo or bow and arrows
- Side arm/hand gun (recommended for protection against hogs, etc)
- Flashlights with extra batteries
- Good sharp knives for cleaning game
- Insect repellent
- Extra layers of clothing to adjust to temperature changes
- Other hunting equipment, such as:
  - Compass and GPS
  - Binoculars
  - Range finder
  - Camera
  - Grunt call
  - Rattling bag
- Ice chests to return home with your meat or the means to cover and transport your game
- Extra ice
- If interested in more game than included in basic hunt, cash or credit card
- Food for your meals, including snacks and drinks
- Personal toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, unscented soap, etc)
- Prescriptions and over the counter medicine for allergies, headaches, etc

### We provide:

- Transportation to and from hunting areas
- A shed to field dress game
- Two bedrooms (4 twin beds each) with attached bathrooms. Includes bedding (pillow, sheets, blankets), towels, and bathroom tissue
- Cooking equipment, refrigerator, plates/cups, and silverware
- Grill/smoker and picnic table available
- Coffee daily
- You may receive calls at 830-683-4325; outgoing calls are restricted except in an emergency. (Cell phones do not work in many areas of the ranch.)

**Note:** It is recommended that you sight-in your rifle before arriving at the ranch, but a target area can be set up if needed.
